Behavior Management Policy

At Christ Church Nursery School, we strive to provide children with a positive and nurturing environment. An atmosphere of co-operation and community is established early in the school year so that children understand they are part of a school “family.” Children are encouraged and guided to express their feelings through words and make appropriate choices for their behavior. Teachers use positive reinforcement and model appropriate behavior and manners. Children learn to behave in ways that allow them to be safe and respectful to others. Redirection and distraction are often used to avoid inappropriate behavior. When children need discipline, they are never belittled, yelled at, or treated harshly. Children are verbally reminded of the rules, and are encouraged to think of more appropriate ways of expressing themselves in the future.

In the event that a child continually misbehaves, a conference is set with the parents, teachers and the Director. Children are rarely sent home, but if they are, it is due to extremely aggressive and/or potentially harmful behavior, resulting in possible harm to others or himself or herself.
